Version 2.1.1

- Support for using Power Export feature to manage scheduled tasks in Windows 10, Windows Server 2016.

Version 2.1.0

- New event log data collection process with provision for specific date range. Removed NTFS Listener service and hence no dependency on it.
- Removed E-mail alerts, Live monitor feature.
- Support for non-English event data.
- Fixed to store 4663 and 4670 events for sub-folders and files activity, when top-level shared folders are configured.

Version 2.0.0

- User Interface enhancements in configuring servers, shares and folders, user/group accounts for change reporting.
- Moved Computer Enumeration section from Configuration Settings dialog to individual shared folder enumeration screen.
- Renamed "Domain Credentials" to "Domain/Server Credentials" in the Configuration Settings dialog.

Version 1.0.1

- Fixed the **Timeout expired** issue that occurred while using SQL database option in the application.

Version 1.0

First version of Change and Access Auditing tool to track and audit all user accesses and changes made to NTFS Shares, Folders and files in servers and workstations in the network.

Features included in the base version:

- **Data Collector Settings:** Configure Share/Folder/File Name and Event ID for which you want to collect change data across servers/workstations. Optionally, you can configure email alert to get instant notification for change data through email.
- **Change Reports:** Generate the change reports for any changes made to the configured Share/Folder/Files in your servers and workstations.
- **Live Monitor:** View the occurrence of all the events for Event IDs configured in the Data Collector Settings tool as soon as they are captured by the application's NTFS Listener Service.
- **Search Change History:** Locate specific events that occurred over a time period and stored in the application's Events History database.
- **Clean up Change History:** Clean up unwanted events and their related data from the application's Events History database.
- **Listener Service Status:** View the subscription status of configured computers. Enables the user to manage the 'NTFS Listener Service' by using the provision to start, stop and restart the service.
